- Track testing progress and prepare test execution and closure reports.
- Identify, log, monitor, and report defects using tools such as Jira, Octane, or similar platforms.
- Automate suitable test scenarios to improve testing efficiency and coverage.
- Develop and execute load and performance testing scenarios.
- Support regression testing activities to ensure application stability.
- Develop a solid understanding of the business domain and technical environment to improve testing effectiveness.
